- **Nuisance:** Noise and nuisance complaints will not be tolerated. If my pet receives two noise complaints, I will be required to remove the pet from the premises immediately.
 - The pet deposit will NOT be refunded.
 - o The lease will remain in effect, but will no longer allow pets on the premises
- **Walk-Thru:** The managing agent will schedule a mandatory walk-thru two weeks after the pet has moved in to make sure no damage is being done to the premises. If damage is found, I will be required to remove the pet from the premises immediately.
 - o The pet deposit will NOT be refunded.
 - o The lease will remain in effect, but will no longer allow pets on the premises
- Ineligible Animals: The following animals are considered 'ineligible'.

- American staffordshire terrier
- Boxer
- Bull terrier
- Bull mastiff
- Chow chow
- Doberman
- Wolf Hybrid (wolf mixed with any breed)
- Guard dog, an attack dog or any dog left in a place of business while closed for business.
- Any dog that is permanently chained outside.
- Animal that has bitten, attacked, or has vicious tendencies such that it must be removed or restrained when people are present.
- Wild undomesticated animals such as reptiles, wolves, snakes, bears, ferrets, monkeys, pot-bellied pigs, certain species of cats (e.g. bobcats, cougars) and other exotic species.
- Tenants agree to abide by the following rules:
 - a. Damage. The Pet may not cause any damage to the Premises.
 - b. Nuisance. The Pet may not cause any discomfort, annoyance, or nuisance to any neighbors or other residents.
 - c. Sanitary Problems. All pets must be housebroken. Poop must be picked up out of the yard routinely. Daily if possible, but at a minimum of twice per week.
 - d. Abandonment. Tenants may not abandon the Pet, leave it for any extended period without food or water, or fail to care for it if it is sick.
 - e. Compliance with Laws. Tenants agree to comply with all applicable governmental laws and regulations as well as any house rules or CC&Rs.
